There was a playpark in full view of the bar area so kids, like our daughter Charlotte, six, can have fun while parents can keep an eye


on them. Ideal. The entertainment starts early evening with a full range of activities for all the family, from disco dancing to bingo.



Check for market times for the best in fresh local produce. There are lots places to eat and drink there, with other options of things to see and do further afield such as Aberfeldy, Blair Atholl, Loch Tay and Bannoch.
